"We currently operate 27 routes and looking ahead, we expect to expand our network to 30 destinations by end of this year; aligning with the aircraft fleet expansion to around 30 Airbus by 2017. To keep up with this growth, we hire on average one staff every two days. We will be recruiting extensively and aiming to double our cabin crew size by hiring an additional 300 cabin crew by the end of next year."

As a fast-growing and leading LCC, HK Express offers world-class development opportunities to its cabin crew. After one year of flying experience with the airline, crew members can apply for a Flight Purser position. The role of Senior Purser is open to application a few years after that. HK Express also appoints Trainers to provide professional instruction to new cabin crew, and offers the Protégé Programme for cabin crew who want to share their knowledge and experience in support of fellow team members.

HK Express is currently 300 cabin crew members strong from which 90% of current cabin crew are Hongkongers. The airline is looking to recruit an additional 100 cabin crew across all three rankings of Senior Purser, Flight Purser and Flight Attendant during this mass recruitment
