HK Express Grows 89% in 2015 The low-fare airline ends the year on a high note

15 January 2016 With another excellent year added to its arsenal, Hong Kong's low-fare airline HK Express has entered 2016 in an enviable position. The airline finished the year strong, with added growth in December 2015 and continued excellent on-time performance.

In its second full year as a low-fare airline, HK Express has flown 2,252,173 Guests aboard its aircraft with 229,898 Guests flying in December alone. By the end of 2015, the low-fare airline saw an 89% increase in the number of Guests flown when compared year-on-year with 2014.

Reflecting incredible dedication to Guest services, the low-fare airline's complaint rate also reduced by 89% in December, compared with the same month in 2014. The popular airline also received overwhelmingly positive feedback in its annual customer satisfaction survey. Guests praised several standout areas of service, such as affordable ticket fares, new routes and attractive promotional offers.

Guests were elated by the low-fare airline's consistent on-time performance (OTP). The OTP rate has remain at an impressive 79.3% year-to-date, as calculated by independent flight statistic monitoring website Flightstats.com.

"It's been a whirlwind ride the past two years but HK Express is aiming even higher in 2016, as we enter our third year as a low-fare carrier," said Andrew Cowen, CEO of HK Express. "In the new year, we will continue to set higher bars, new benchmarks and grow our services to make travel accessible and affordable for regional travellers."

The New Year is sure to bring more successes for Hong Kong's favorite low-fare airline. Beginning the year with two top awards, HK Express was named Asia's safest low-fare airline by independent site AirlineRankings.com, as well as 'Most Popular Airline' by popular travelogue DAYDOW Trip's Ranking of Life on the Road competition.

In the year to come, HK Express is getting ready to welcome a fleet of more efficient A320neo and A321 aircraft, as well as launch numerous new direct flights to exciting points in the Asia/Pacific area, including Guam, Saipan, Luang Pragang, Yangon and Mandalay.
