**Strong Business Performance Continues
Hong Kong's Low-Fare Airline Sees Impressive Growth in 2016**

Hong Kong, 21 November 2016 Following 9 months of rapid growth, Hong Kong's low-fare airline HK Express finished October with a surge in passenger numbers, ancillary revenue and ever improving Guest satisfaction.

The airline flew 258,761 Guests in the month of October, representing a 17.5% increase compared with the same month last year. In the past 12 months, HK Express flew 2,852,419 Guests, a 36.4% improvement over the same period last year.

HK Express has continued its growth in load factor, topping 88% in October 2016, up 1 point on October 2015 levels. Load factor is a measure of how healthy the airline is in attracting Guests and keeping its planes full. HK Express' load factor year to date has been consistently around the 89% mark, rising 3 points on same period 2015 and beating other airlines based in Hong Kong.

With the introduction of additional features for guests such as U-First, the priority check-in and boarding offering for those regular fliers, HK Express has seen a jump in ancillary revenue. In the month of October, ancillary revenue increased to 27.5% of total revenue putting it among the highest low-fare airlines in the world. The additional ancillary revenue – which is optional for Guests – means that the airline can continue to drive down its air fares.

“Going forward, we will continue to diversify our revenue streams with more useful services for our Guests.” Said Andrew Cowen, CEO and Managing Director of HK Express. “Allowing guests to choose what they want, ensures a more efficient business and one that allows us to focus on driving air fares down still further”.

As HK Express services expand, so does its loyal following. The Guest complaint ratio has remained consistent at 0.12% over the past 12 months. During the month of October, Guest complaints have decreased by 32% when compared with the same month last year.

The end of 2016 will see more exciting expansion across the route map. HK Express currently operates a total of 25 routes, with new destinations expected soon, including Chiang Rai in November, Hualien and Guam in December, and Saipan next January.
